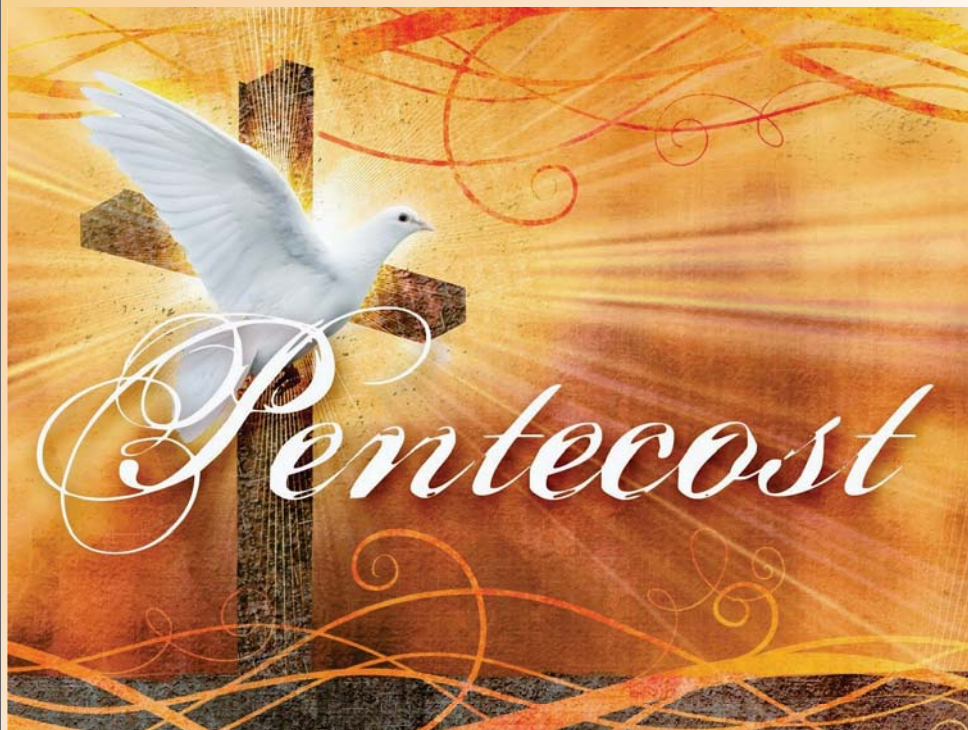

THIS WEEK'S: *Pentecost Sunday*

First Reading —

(Acts of the Apostles 2:1-11)

Responsorial Psalm — (Psalm 104)

Second Reading —

(1 Corinthians 12:3-7, 12-13)

Gospel — (Luke 24:46-53)

NEXT WEEK'S: *The Most Holy Trinity*

First Reading—Theologically, this text is somewhat ambiguous, for the Christian tradition has understood Wisdom as representing both Christ and the Holy Spirit. This week's text represents an early understanding of Wisdom who, though personified as embodying human characteristics, is not really presented as a person. Over time, the ancient writers would better understand Wisdom as a manifestation of God's activity and self-communication in the world.

(Proverbs 8:22-31)

Responsorial Psalm—"O Lord, our God, how wonderful your name in all the earth!"

(Psalm 8)

Second Reading—Paul uses a Trinitarian formula to rejoice over the salvation "God" accomplished "through our Lord Jesus Christ" and sustains "through the Holy Spirit."

Paul explains that—"affliction" makes us strong and gives us "endurance." Endurance builds "character" and character gives us reason to "hope," a hope that "does not disappoint."

Paul believes that if Christ makes a difference, He makes a difference in all things, stands with us in all things, and makes all things possible—even seeing through our pain to the glory that awaits us and standing in our pain with confidence that the Holy Spirit "that has been given to us" is a consuming fire that can transform anything into a sacrifice of praise.

(Romans 5:1-5)

Gospel—Taken from the Last Supper discourse, this brief text presents Jesus, as ever, trying to care for His disciples with careful explanations. The "Spirit of truth" will make clear all that they have learned from Jesus; the Spirit will come, not to bring new revelations, but to help them understand what they have already heard and experienced.

(John 16:12-15)
